

**Fleet Readiness Center Western Pacific (FRCWESTPAC)
Specific Hazardous Material/Hazardous Waste (HAZMAT/HAZWASTE) Spill Procedures**

1. Upon discovery of a hazardous substance spillage or leakage

a. Move upwind of the area immediately. Remain close enough to the area to warn other personnel. When opportunity presents, notify the closest supervisor, HAZMAT/HAZWASTE Control & Management Program (HMC&M) coordinator, Safety and Occupational Health (SOH) coordinator, or safety manager. After you have notified the appropriate individuals, remain upwind and warn others of the spill until an individual capable of responding to the spill arrives.

b. Supervisors or HMC&M Coordinator shall notify:

On-Scene Commander (OSC)DSN: 315-264-4777
Command Duty Officer (CDO)090-2235-0290

Supply Equipment Rework Facility (SERF) OfficerDSN: 315-264-2780

2. Interim Controls

a. Keep other workers away; if safe, isolate the area, ~20', with yellow tape, cones, etc.. Direct personnel upwind of the spill. Post "DO NOT ENTER" signs in English and Japanese.

3. OSC shall activate the FRCWESTPAC Spill Contingency Plan. Only authorized properly trained personnel shall respond to a HAZMAT/HAZWASTE spill.

4. Have a copy of the Hazardous Waste Inventory and MSDS's ready for use by spill team members.

5. Equipment

a. Fire Hydrant. A fire hydrant is located East of Building 497, near Kamomedori Street, the main road.

b. Fire Extinguishers. Dry Chemical Types are located at numerous places in SERF.

c. Spill Kits. Numerous spill kits are maintained throughout SERF. They are in Gray Plastic boxes.

Post this contingency plan.
