NOTE THE FOLLOWING STIPULATIONS:

- (1) PERSONNEL WILL NOT WORK ALONE! ATTENDANTS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL CONFINED SPACE ENTRIES.
- (2) CONTACT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY.
- (3) IF THERE IS ANY CHANGE IN OPERATION, CONTACT THE SAFETY OFFICE IMMEDIATELY TO HAVE THE SPACE RE-EVALUATED, BEFORE WORK BEGINS.
- (4) ALL PERSONNEL INVOLVED IN CONFINED SPACE ENTRY OR WORK SHALL BE FAMILIAR WITH AND UNDERSTAND THE PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS OF OPNAVINST 5100.23G, CHAPTER 27, CONFINED SPACE ENTRY PROGRAM (NON-MARITIME).
- (5) ALL CONFINED SPACE ENTRY PERSONNEL SHALL WEAR/USE THE PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING AS STATED ON THIS PERMIT.
- (6) WHEN SO INDICATED BY ATMOSPHERIC TESTING AND/OR THE NATURE OF OPERATIONS TO BE CONDUCTED, ALL CONFINED SPACE SHALL BE PROPERLY VENTILATED PRIOR TO ENTRY AND DURING THE COURSE OF THE OPERATION.
- (7) CONTROL OF ENERGY SOURCES, ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL, SHALL BE NOTED ON THE CONFINED SPACE PERMIT (INCLUDING POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS VALVES OR PIPES).
